Cross-border traffic of passenger road motor vehicles and passengers, second quarter 20251

The total incoming border traffic to Bosnia and Herzegovina in the second quarter of 2025 amounted to slightly more than 6.12 million passengers. The total number of passengers at the entrance during the second quarter of 2025 is lower by 6.5% compared to the same period of the previous year. The number of domestic passengers decreased by 13.1%, while the number of foreign passengers decreased by 2.7% compared to the second quarter of 2024.

Of the total number of passengers who entered BiH, 33.7% were domestic passengers and 66.3% were foreign passengers. In relation to the type of traffic, the largest part of cross-border passenger traffic refers to road cross-border traffic (93.0%).

The total number of passengers on exit from Bosnia and Herzegovina in the second quarter of 2025 decreased by 12.7% compared to the same quarter of the previous year. The number of domestic passengers at the exit decreased by 20.2%, while the number of foreign passengers decreased by 7.7% compared to the same period of the previous year.


The total incoming border traffic of passenger road motor vehicles to Bosnia and Herzegovina in the second quarter of 2025 amounted to slightly more than 2.59 million vehicles. In the structure of road border traffic, 24.9% were domestic passenger motor vehicles, and 75.1% were foreign passenger motor vehicles.

The total number of passenger motor vehicles that entered Bosnia and Herzegovina in the second quarter of 2025 is lower by 11.9% compared to the same period of the previous year. The number of vehicles with domestic registration decreased by 34.9%, while the number of foreign passenger motor vehicles decreased by 0.3%.

The number of passenger road motor vehicles on exit from Bosnia and Herzegovina decreased by 10.6% compared to the same period in 2024. The number of vehicles with BiH registration plates at the exit decreased by 18.8%, while the number of vehicles with foreign registration plates decreased by 6.1%.

The largest number of vehicles entered through the border crossings with Croatia 66.5%, Serbia 26.4%, and Montenegro 7.0%.



NOTES ON METHODOLOGY

Source and methods of data collection

The data source for cross-border traffic of cars, motorcycles, busses and road passenger transport operations and cross-border traffic of passengers in railway transport, sea transport on inland waterways and air transport are the records of the Border Police of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

Coverage

The scope of the research included all road border crossings, and all rail, maritime, moves on inland waterways and air border crossings, regardless of whether they are permanent or seasonal.

Data includes all motor vehicles and travellers who have crossed the border into Bosnia and Herzegovina and came from Bosnia and Herzegovina.

Motor vehicles are passenger vehicles that are passenger cars and buses.

Passenger motor vehicles are divided into domestic and foreign. Passengers are classified by citizenship in domestic and foreign. Data on the input and output of passenger cars, buses and passenger vehicles, and they include passengers in transit through Bosnia and Herzegovina. Passengers in the border traffic are also included in the total coverage.

Definitions

The border crossing is a place intended for crossing the state border.

Border crossings can be international, interstate or frontier. Can be road, rail, air moves inland waterways and maritime.

Border crossings for international traffic are intended border traffic of citizens of Bosnia and Herzegovina and the citizens of neighbouring countries.

Border crossings for interstate traffic are intended border traffic of citizens of Bosnia and Herzegovina and the citizens of neighbouring countries.

Border crossings for border traffic intended for border traffic of citizens certain areas of Bosnia and Herzegovina, and certain areas of the neighbouring countries under an international agreement.

Road vehicle is a vehicle which is exclusively or mainly projected to carry one or more people. Road vehicle designed to carry passengers are: motorcycles, passenger cars, buses and others.

A motorcycle is a motor vehicle on a road two, three or four wheels whose unlade mass not exceeding 400 kg. They cover all vehicles engine capacity of 50 cm3 or more, as the vehicle engine displacement less than 50 cm3, which does not belong to the category moped.

Passenger car is a road motor vehicle for transporting passengers, with seating for up to nine adults (including the driver).

Bus travel is a road vehicle designed in twenty-four or more seats (including the driver) and constructed exclusively for the carriage of seated passengers.
